ST. CANICE'S HALL - Over the last several years St. Canice's Hall has been running at a loss and costing the parish considerable expense. In earlier years Bingo made a profit which helped to reduce the cost but in the past two years, with falling numbers attending, the Bingo itself was running at a loss and had to be supported from parish funds. At the end of 2014 our Bingo, with competition elsewhere in the town, closed.

Mr John McElhinney who manages the Hall for the parish gives generously of his time to supervise functions; he does this voluntarily and does not get paid a wage. It is very doubtful and unlikely that when John retires that there will be anyone who will be willing to take on his duties on the same basis.

Over the past period, the Parish Finance Committee has been monitoring the performances from St. Canice's Hall and the deficit has been a concern to them. Our hope always had been to cater for the requirements of all Hall users and while we did not want a profit neither did we want a continuing substantial loss. Our wish always was to provide for the activities of the various groups who use the Hall. St. Canice's Hall is an old building and would require a substantial amount of money to be spent on it to modernise it and bring it up to required standard i.e. disabled toilet facilities, upgrade kitchen, heating, lighting, insulation etc. Nowadays it is very difficult to get people who are willing to give of their time voluntarily to organise and run functions or events. Legislation has now also changed with supervision for groups of children.

Recently the Irish Cultural Organisation, Glór, have been seeking premises for a Culturelann, a Centre where music, drama and allied Irish cultural events could be presented in Dungiven. The Organisation felt that St. Canice's Hall was a suitable venue for their requirements and approached me wanting to know if we would be willing to sell the Hall. In discussions, when they agreed to continue to accommodate all existing users of the Hall if they managed it, it was felt proper by the Parish Finance Committee and the Diocesan Authorities to consider selling St. Canice's. The added advantage under their administration would be that many cultural events would be available to the Dungiven community. In the light of these reflections it was decided to transfer the ownership of St. Canice's to Glór Dungiven. We are in the process of achieving this transfer.
