Pope Francis has chosen Ireland to host the 9th World Meeting of Families during 2018. It is expected to attract thousand of Catholic families from around the globe to Ireland. It is hoped that this very special pastoral initiative will present all of us in the Church with the opportunity, and the challenge, to renew, support and strengthen Irish families in their commitment to their faith.

Hosting a global event of this size requires a huge amount of planning and financial outlay on behalf of the host country. To support this event we intend to hold three national church collections, the first will be taken up next weekend **18th / 19th June.** The remaining will take place in 2017 & 2018.
