I am Father Joseph Varghese, a native of Kerala, South West India, where I was ordained 19 years ago as a Priest in the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church. (The Syro-Malabar Church is an Apostolic Church which traces its origin to the Apostle St. Thomas who landed in South India in 52 AD and founded several Christian Communities. Today this is the second largest Eastern Church in Catholic communion with the See of Rome)

After 9 years of parish work at home in my Archdiocese I was sent to London for higher studies and Parish work. Following that, I was invited to the Diocese of Derry in 2010 and have been ministering in St. Eugene's Cathedral, Longtower and Waterside parishes and also acting as chaplain to the Syro-Malabar Community in the

As you are aware, there is serous shortage of priests and changes are necessary to fill vacancies and cover Parish work as best possible. For that reason Bishop McKeown has transferred me to Dungiven as curate in the Parish. I had been here on a few occasions to cover temporary needs and was impressed by your welcome and concern.
