**THE TRADITION OF THE JESSE TREE.** – It is a very old Christmas tradition and started in medieval times. They are used to help tell the story of the Bible from Creation to the Christmas Story.

The name comes from Jesse who was the father of the great Jewish King, David. One prophecy in the Bible, in the book of Isaiah say: "A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a branch will bear fruit'

A branch is a sign of new life and new beginnings. Jesus was a descendent of King David and Christians believe that Jesus is this new branch.

The symbols hanging from the branches on our Jesse tree in church, tell the story from Creation to the birth of Jesus. (JPII Students)
