ABOUT THE MASS WITH KATH AND QUMEN. The Four Parts Of The Eucharistic Prayer - The first part of the Eucharistic Prayer is called the Preface. During the Preface we give thanks for the good things that God has done for us throughout all time. The Preface ends when we pray the Sanctus, or Holy, Holy. The second part of the Eucharistic Prayer is called the Epiclesis, when the priest asks God to send the Holy Spirit to come down upon our gifts of bread and wine. The third part of the Eucharistic Prayer is called the Institution Narrative, when we remember what Jesus did at the Last Supper. The fourth and final part of the Eucharistic Prayer is called the Anamnesis when we pray for those in need and those who have died. At the end of the Anamnesis the priest holds up the host and the chalice and offers them to God.

We also believe that the proposal will be perceived as very damaging to the integrity of the democratic process. We urge your commission to scrap these proposals and go back to the drawing board.***
