- Leaving Dungiven: Chapel Car park at **6.45 am. sharp.**
- Leaving Maghera car park (at the flyover) at **7.00 am. sharp.**
- Breakfast in Newry at 9.00 am. *(Please let us know as soon as possible of any food allergies.)*
- Arrive at Transport Hub, Dublin, 11.00 am. approx.
- Walking distance 2½ - 4½ miles.
- Rest zones available during the walk, also medical facilities, toilets and multiple food and drink stations.
- Pope Mobile drive 2.30 pm. approx.
- Mass: 3.00 - 4.45 pm.
- Make way back to the Transport Hub to get the bus for the journey home.
- Long delays expected, we may not get leaving Dublin until 9.00 pm.
