On behalf of the National Finance Committee for World Meeting of Families, Firstly, I thank you and your parishioners for your generous response to the recent church collections for WMOF, which enabled the successful hosting of the event in August, including the historic visit of Pope Francis to our country. The overall cost to the Church in Ireland for hosting WMOF came to €19.4m. To date €15.4m has been raised by way of local church collections and by other donations. This leaves the Church with a deficit of €4m. In order to help defray this debt I am asking you, once again, for your support in promoting the fifth national collection which will take place in churches across Ireland, the weekend 10th & 11th Nov.
