RE: PROPOSED NEW SEATS AT ST. PATRICK'S CHURCH, DUNGIVEN

The existing church seats which were made in the 1960's in the local workshop of Henry O'Kane have served the church well for the past 55 years.

Due to the passing of time and matters of wear and tear it is considered appropriate to carry out an upgrade with the installation of new seats, which will add to the major refurbishment of the church carried out 9 years ago by Fr Aidan. It was his intention to carry out such further renewal and since he left we have received a donation, which will cover the cost of new seating.

It is proposed that new quality seating of oak hardwood be installed with a design which reflects some of the arching shapes within the church and with carved cross motifs on the seat gables. Comfort of the seat is an important matter, both for sitting, standing and kneeling.

A sample seat has been made to the proposed design and detail and installed in the church to let members of the congregation see the nature and quality of the seat, and to experience the matters related to comfort. (*Placed at the porch on graveyard side of the church*).
