DERRY DIOCESAN VOCATIONS WEEK 17TH - 25TH APRIL 2021

The annual celebration of Derry Diocesan Vocations Week begins Saturday, 17th April through to Good Shepherd Sunday. 25th April. The theme for this year's Vocations Week is based on "Patris Corde" ('With a Father's Heart'), Pope Francis' recent publication for the year of Saint Joseph.

Parishioners are encouraged to participate in the schedule of daily prayer and Mass. as well as devotional reflections based on the Angelus, Daily Examen and the Mysteries of the Rosary. These resources will be available online at derrydiocese.org and derryvocations.org On the evenings of Monday, 19th April -Friday, 23rd April, Bishop Donal will host a series of interviews with guests from throughout the diocese discussing how they have answered God's call to These vocation. twenty-minute interviews will be broadcast live online at 7.00 pm., followed by a broadcast of the celebration of the Daily Examen. At 8.00 pm. after evening Mass, Bishop Donal will lead the Rosary before concluding with night prayer. The live broadcasts can be viewed at derrydiocese.org and derryvocations.org at the specific times.
