Join Pope Francis in the Rosary Marathon for an End to COVID-19 The Rosary Marathon will be taking place in shrines across the world this May.

Pope Francis has requested that the Church comes together to pray the rosary every day throughout May for an end to the pandemic. The Pope will be joining 30 shrines across the world throughout the month of May, with a different intention to be prayed for each day. The marathon begins this Saturday 1st May, at the shrine of the Basilica of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk.

In response to the Holy Father's heartfelt wish, the month of May will be dedicated to a "marathon" of prayer, to ask for the end of the pandemic, which has afflicted the world for more than a year now, and to ask for the resumption of social and work activities. Pope Francis wishes to involve all the Shrines around the world in this initiative, so that they may become vehicles of the prayer of the entire Church. The initiative is being conducted in the light of the biblical expression: "Prayer by the Church was fervently

being made to God" (Acts 12:5).

The Holy Father will open and close the prayer, along with the faithful around the world, from two significant locations within the Vatican City State. On May 1st, Pope Francis will pray at Our Lady of Succor (*or Our Lady of Help*), an icon venerated as early as the seventh century. People are invited to join Pope Francis and the world each morning in our church at 9.30 am. (8.30 am. on Sundays) when this rosary and special prayers for and an end to the Pandemic will be recited. This will start after the vigil Mass on Saturday 1st May.
