HEARING AID SUPPORT SESSION

RNID is resuming its free drop-in support session for hearing aid users in Hands That Talk, Main Street, Dungiven on Tuesday 6th July from 12 noon – 1.00 pm.

The socially distanced drop off and pick up service provides new batteries, cleaning and retubing of ear moulds for N.H.S hearing aids.

Hearing aids must be placed in a labelled envelope with name and contact details. They will be collected at the entrance by a volunteer and brought inside for maintenance. Users can wait in their car or return later to collect hearing aids. Hearing aids can also be dropped off by friends or family members.
