Basic truths you will learn about in the Seminars

1. God loves you and wants you to live a fully happy life. Jesus said I came that they might have life and have it abundantly (Jn 10:10)

2. Man is sinful and separated from God and therefore he cannot know God's love and share in God's life with others. Sin involves indifference to God.

3. Jesus Christ is the only one who can give you power to live this life. Through him you can know God's love and share in God's life with others. God so loved the world that he sent his only son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. (Jn 3:16) God enters our world in the Man Jesus. I am the way the truth and the life: no man comes to the Father but through me (Jn 14:6).

4. Accepting Jesus into your life. This is more than just believing. The Gift of the Spirit in all four Gospels John the Baptism says of Jesus. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit Mk 1:8

Jesus promised the Holy Spirit to his followers. Jn 16:12-13. Acts 1:5 The power of the Spirit was evident in the early Church. Pentecost. The promise fulfilled Acts 2:4.
