CONFIRMATION DAY

SY Bishop Donal McKeown will Ĭ administer the Sacrament of Confirmation in Saint Patrick's Church on Saturday 12th March at 11.00 am. for St. Canice's. At 2.00 pm. for St. John's, St. Mary's & St. Matthew's. On Saturday 19th March in St. Patrick's

Church at 11.00 am. for Gaelscoil Neachtain.

Cars should not be parked within the church grounds of (St. Patrick's) on that occasion. (Please use our car park). There will be 1 pew allocated to each family, this includes the Candidate and the Sponsor. The Candidates for Confirmation, the Sponsors and the Parents should be seated in the church not later than 10.30 am. and 1.30 pm. The candidate, sponsor and parents will be seated together in the seat reserved for them.

Sponsors: A sponsor should be not less than 16 years of age, be a Catholic who has been confirmed, and can be of either gender. The sponsor at the child's baptism would be the most suitable sponsor for Confirmation. Sponsor may not be a parent of the child.

Calling of the Candidates: After the Gospel the Parish Priest calls the candidates in these words: "As Parish Priest I ask the children of this parish to indicate their willingness to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation". Each candidate is called by name and stands. The Parish Priest then addresses the Bishop in these words: "I assure you, Bishop that these children have received the necessary instruction. I therefore present them to you to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation." The Bishop then addresses the children; they

renew their baptismal vows, and the teacher/steward will tell you when to come up to the altar to be confirmed. Sponsor: At the Confirmation ceremony each child is presented to the Bishop by a Sponsor, who places his/her right hand on the child's shoulder and tells the Bishop the child's Confirmation Name. The Bishop anointing the child with the Oil of Chrism says, "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit" and the child answers "Amen". The Bishop says "Peace be with you" and the child answers "And With Your Spirit". The placing of the right hand on the child's shoulder by the sponsor is a way of saying to the child: "I am with you in what is now happening. I present vou to receive the Holy Spirit in this Sacrament. I want you to grow up as a true follower of Jesus. I am going to give you good example to grow in the love of God".
