
Baptism - Children must have One Godparent who is over 16 years of age and a practicing Catholic. Normally

LEARNING ABOUT THE MASS WITH KATH AND QUMEN. EUCHARIST: The word 'Eucharist' is another name for the Mass. It comes from a Greek word meaning 'thanksgiving'. The whole Mass is a special prayer of thanksgiving for all that God has given us. Sometimes we use the word to describe the whole Mass and sometimes it is used to describe the Bread of Life. We also talk about the sacrifice of the Mass. This reminds us of the sacrifice that Jesus made for us when he suffered and died on the cross.

VOCATIONS - Our prayer this weekend for the seminarians of the diocese of Derry and for those discerning their vocation is taken from the words of St. Paul in our second reading: "May the God of peace make you perfect and holy; and may you all be kept safe and blameless, spirit, soul and body.... God has called you and he will not fail you."

For this past several decades, each year on Gaudete Sunday, the Third Sunday of Advent, children (and adults) bring their Baby Jesus figures from the crib at their homes to St. Peter's Square where the Pope will bless both the people and the figurines during the Angelus.
